Guidelines for Communion Meditation Development:

1. Focus on **JESUS'** purpose. Please try and avoid going off on unrelated tangents, or personal stories.
2. **Keep it brief.** 2-4 minutes, please. (Remember this is not a sermon, and we also want to be considerate of primary/junior church children and teachers in the basement)
3. Strive to connect people to the purpose Jesus established. The Gospel.
4. Be creative. Paint a vivid picture of remembrance or a memorial.
5. Build a parallel idea. (From other Biblical references)
6. Make Jesus' sacrifice the only reason we are doing this. Communion **IS** the "**life-blood**" of the church.
7. Don't make Jesus' Memorial trivial. Show the significance of the ordinance.
8. Practice, practice, practice. So you can deliver this from your heart.
9. Spend time in prayer. Don't cheat God or your hearers.
10. Spend time in the Word. Jesus can be found in ALL 66 books of the Bible.

Guidelines for Stewardship Meditation Development:

1. Focus on the joy of blessing others. (being an extension of God's "hand")
2. Focus on the privilege of participating in building the Kingdom of God on earth now. (laying a sure foundation for eternity)
3. **Keep it brief (2-4 min.).** (Again, remember this is not a sermon, and we also want to be considerate of primary/junior church children and teachers in the basement.)
4. Short vivid stories are attention grabbers.
5. Never, never, never, attempt to use guilt as a motivator.
6. Do not make reference to a budget shortfall, if we have any. (Don't "*chase*" after or beg for \$\$\$)
7. Give them a vision of what can be accomplished through our faithfulness.
8. Express the idea that we are in the business of sharing hope from God.
9. Draw on being "stewards," care-takers of all of God's good gifts to us.
10. Make it positive.
