Key questions to invite the Spirit to address:

- Is this really **true**, or is this a **lie**?
- Is this the devil's **accusation** or Your **conviction**?
- What am I putting my **hope** in: God's Word or work, or someone else's?
- How do the truth of Jesus's life/death/resurrection address this **thought** or **belief**?
- What about Jesus do I need to **remember** right now?

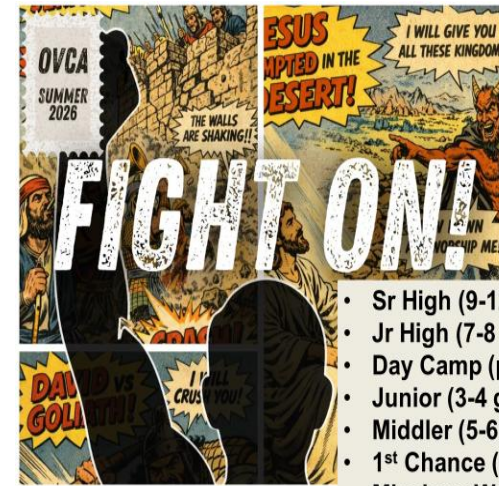
